More than 1,000 refugees have drowned in the Mediterranean Sea so far this year. 8,300 were rescued from the water over the Easter weekend alone. Unicef warn that the death toll is likely to be far higher because unaccompanied minors' deaths frequently go unreported. The Jesuit Refugee Service advocates for, supports and accompanies many refugees and asylum seekers in this country. You can help their work by donating toiletries during Refugee Week. We will be collecting at Masses on 17th / 18th and 24th / 25th June.
