Justice and Peace

Recent estimates from UNICEF are that, around the world, 5.3 million people have fled the conflict in Syria, 4 million people have been displaced from their homes in South Sudan, 4.1 million have been forced to flee violence in the Democratic Republic of Congo, and since late August last year, more than 655,000 Rohingya (nearly half of whom are children) have fled violence in Myanmar's Rakhine State into Bangladesh.
