The day starts at 12 noon, when there will be an event for families. At 4.00pm, Christians from churches across London will gather to pray with Archbishops and church leaders including Archbishop of Westminster, Cardinal Vincent Nichols and the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby.
