Thank you to those who attended our Community lunch on 14th July. We raised £150 which had been sent to Cafod in support of their climate change campaign 'Our Common Home'.

Peace Day – 21 September. This day has been adopted by the UN as an annual day of ceasefire and non-violence. This year is the 20th anniversary of Peace Day.
