**Justice and Peace News**

Peace Day – 21 September. This day has been adopted by the UN as an annual day of ceasefire and non-violence. This year is the 20th anniversary of Peace Day. Building upon the success of previous Peace Days and hoping to encourage as many people as possible to take action to reduce violence, the theme of the day this year is “Who will you make peace with”.

We hope that individuals as well as groups will come together on Saturday 21 September 2019 at the Church, starting with morning Mass. We shall end at noon by observing one minute of silence for peace.
