Justice and Peace News

Peace Day – 21 September. This day has been adopted by the UN as an annual day of ceasefire and non-violence. This year is the 20th anniversary of Peace Day. Building upon the success of previous Peace Days and hoping to encourage as many people as possible to take action to reduce violence, the theme of the day this year is “Who will you make peace with”.

We hope that individuals as well as groups will come together on Saturday 21 September 2019 at the Church, starting with morning Mass. Then at 10.30 we shall mark the day by sharing a few words to encourage and inspire one another: prose or poetry, or our own thoughts and prayers. We shall end at noon by observing one minute of silence for peace.

During the summer break please do think about what you can share with us. It need only be very short. Over the summer there will be more information put up in the church and in early September there will be a sign-up sheet available with time slots for you to fill.

Lewisham Foodbank

We have just delivered more food and goods to the Lewisham Foodbank. Many thanks to all who continue to donate so generously.

Between 1st April 2018 and 31st March 2019 the Foodbank network distributed 1.6 million 3-day emergency supplies to people in crisis. This was a 19% increase on the previous year. More than half a million of these went to children.
